

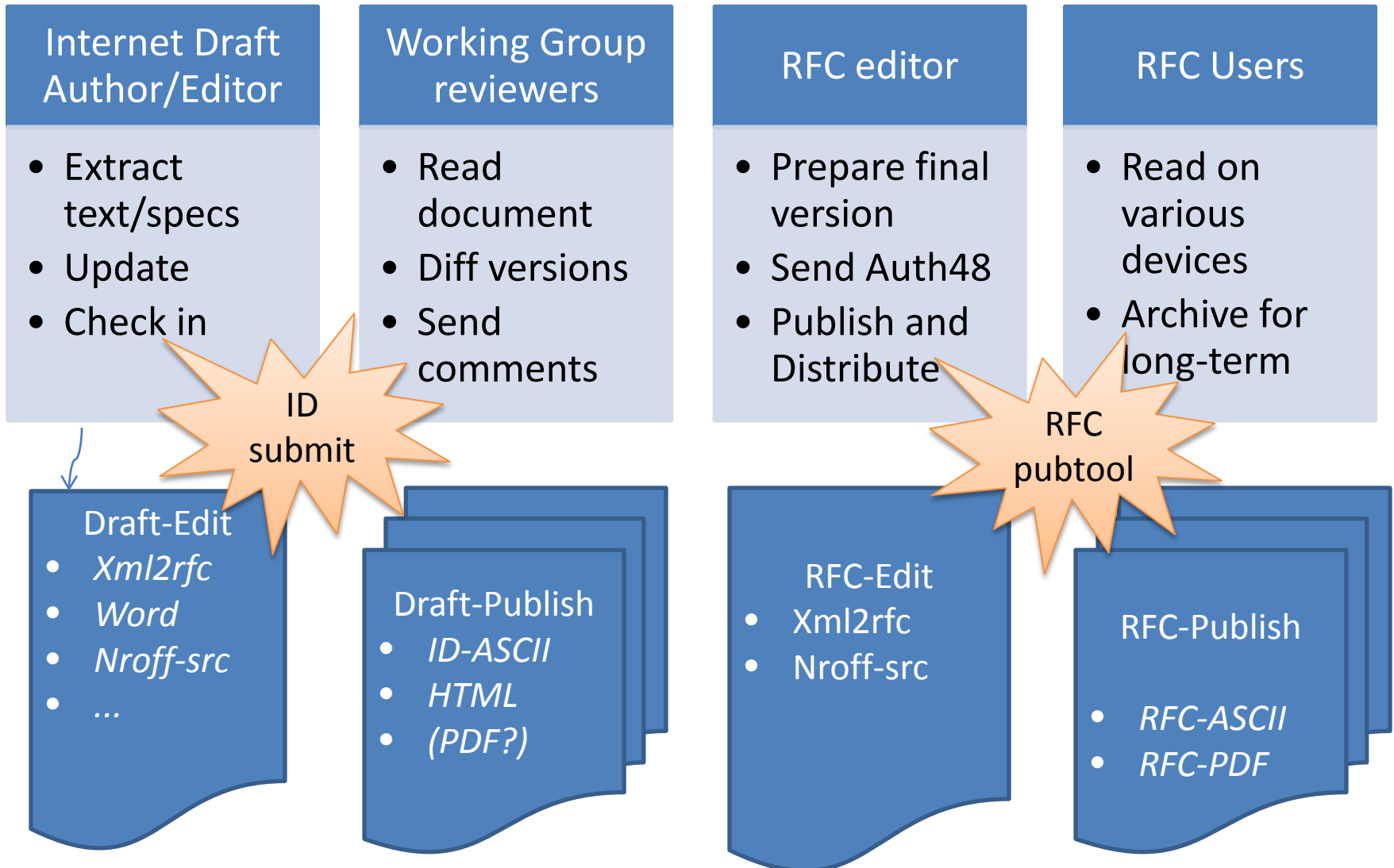

Draft & RFC Workflow



Principles

- Each step has separate requirements
- Allow alternate draft-author
- Supply multiple review / use formats
 - Only one is authoritative
 - The more alternatives, the more work insuring consistency
- Different communities have different requirements

Incremental improvements

- Enhance tooling to improve quality of currently allowed formats
 - e.g.,
 - XML2RFC enhancements for Unicode alternatives
 - Reflowable PDF/A with source attachments
- Add additional Draft- and RFC-publish formats
 - Flowable text
 - HTML, ePub
 - XML source
 - PDF/A with XML source / RFC-ascii attachments
- Only after sufficient tooling for automation

Tool enhancements

- ID-Submit time:
XML2RFC update to allow alternatives for richer versions
- Publish-RFC time:
 - Publish .html and .html.pdf alternatives
 - Publish .xml source
 - Produce ePub version?
